Qualification:

1. M.Sc./M.tech/ Botany/ Zoology/ Biotechnology/ Life Sciences or any other allied Biological Sciences field and must have second class Master degree with a minimum of 55% marks for general category (50% in case of SC/ST/PH) or M.Phil in the subject concerned or a related subject.
2. Experience with DNA sequencing and computational databases and programming (MYSQL, Perl etc.) are desirable.
3. The candidate should be below the age of 40 years at the time of appointment.
