Online Essay Composition and Presentation Competition –Final Result.

Sri Aurobindo College organized a first of its kind Pan-India "Online Essay Composition and Presentation Competition" on the theme of 'Covid-19: Issues and Challenges'. The first round of the competition (Essay Writing) was a thundering success with 116 entries received in Hindi and English from undergraduate students belonging to 13 diverse states and 66 colleges/universities across India. Ten shortlisted participants moved to the final round in which they had to present the arguments of their essays before a panel of judges on an online platform. The competition witnessed an intensely fought battle of oral and written skills as the top ten contestants vied for prizes worth 18k. Vaishnavi Tiwari from Jesus and Mary College, Kritika Kapoor from Dyal Singh College and Kripal Mishra from Ramanujan College bagged the top three prizes.
