RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DUSU ELECTIONS 2024-25

In view of the ongoing campaigning across the college campus for the upcoming Delhi University Student Union Elections – 2024-25, the Student Advisory Committee of the college has issued some guidelines for the candidates as well as the accompanying students.

GUIDELINES

- Destruction or defacement of college property shall not be tolerated at any cost.
- Campaigners must not disrupt any academic activities or the functioning of the
 college. The only permissible slot in the corridors is the time of transition between
 two classes when the teacher is not present in the class and not more than 5 to 6
 students at a time will be allowed.
- Unauthorised large gatherings or any action that disturbs the decorum of the college can lead to disciplinary action.
- Posters or pamphlets of the candidates shall not be pasted or thrown in the college premises, including classrooms.
- The students shall conduct themselves at all times, in a way that is not intimidating, threatening, or provoking others.
- Vulgar or profane language during campaigns across the campus shall not be tolerated at any cost. It shall amount to unprofessional behaviour and a degradation to the image of the college.
- 7. Students should not indulge in any form of discrimination or harassment based on ethnic group identification, race, colour, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, national origin, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, marital status, political affiliation or any other legally protected status unrelated to legitimate interests of the college.

The students are requested to adhere to the above listed guidelines. Any violations shall result in stringent action against the students, including fine, suspension or even expulsion from the institution.
